### RISK FACTORS

McKee Botanical Garden's summer program is ideal for children interested in learning about Florida's wildlife and natural environment. Even though many safety precautions exist, there is always the potential to be injured, bitten or scratched when working with live animals and exploring nature. It is important that you understand and accept these risks before registering your child for this summer program. It is also important that you and your child understand that appropriate behavior is required at all times.



#### WAIVER FOR MINORS

I accept all risks inherent to the summer education programs at McKee Botanical Garden, including the additional risks that exist when working with or around wild animals and exploring the outdoors, and do hereby release McKee Botanical Garden, its third-party vendors, as well as their directors, officers, agents, employees, and members from all liability for injury during the summer program activities.
